- c. Places of public amusement and activity.** Whether indoors or outdoors, places of public amusement and activity are closed, including but not limited to amusement parks, carnivals, water parks, licensed public or private swimming pools, splash pads, aquariums, zoos, museums, arcades, fairs, children’s play centers, playgrounds, funplexes, theme parks, bowling alleys, movie and other theaters, concert and music halls, country clubs, social clubs, and gyms and fitness centers. The following exceptions apply:

The Pool Committee along with the Village of Melrose Board of Trustees has passed a motion to **CLOSE** the Swimming Pool for the 2020 Season. Public meetings were held on Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 6:00 PM and 7:00 PM to discuss opening and operating the swimming pool for the 2020 season.

The following motions were passed unanimously:

1. Motion made to close the Swimming Pool for the 2020 Season
2. Motion made to make repairs to existing skimmers

This was not an easy decision, so we were diligent in reviewing guidelines provided by the CDC. Our biggest concern is keeping our families safe and healthy, as well as the financial setback of not being able to run at full capacity. We have chosen to take this time to make repairs, so that the pool will be ready when allowed to open. We appreciate your patience during this difficult time.
